



Did you

make a New Year's resolution?

Four years ago, in a women's Sunday school class, we were challenged to sit with the Father, soaking in his presence, and listening to him regarding the upcoming new year. Specifically, asking Him to reveal a 'Word' for the year.

At different times in the past, I have made New Year's resolutions, often with very good intentions, only to quickly forget or quit. Honestly, my heart wasn't in it. However, this idea of having a 'Heart to Heart' connection with the Father, hearing his heart for me, was what I longed for.

I asked, "Father, what do you have for me this year? What areas within me do you want to refine and mold more and more into your image? (Mark 11:24, Hebrews 11:6)
