“Look at how much encouragement you’ve found in your relationship with the Anointed One! You are filled to overflowing with his comforting love. Little words can have a great impact. I want to bring your attention to a tiny little word in scripture. A word barely noticed. Easily overlooked. It is a word that would not necessarily be attributed to Jesus, but there it is. In the book of Mark, a man who was deaf and had difficulty speaking was brought to Jesus and it says they begged Him to place His hand on him. Here is

the response from Jesus, **“and looking up to heaven, He sighed deeply” Mark 7:34** The definition of the word, sigh means to emit a long, deep, audible breath expressing sadness, relief, tiredness, or a similar feeling.
